reasonable efforts to find employment for the building have been unsuccessful and that it would meet a

specific identified local housing need.

2. Policy 16 of the submitted South Worcestershire Development Plan states, amongst other $\,$

requirements, that development of Rural Exception sites need to demonstrate a proven and as yet

unmet local need and that there are secure arrangements to ensure that housing will remain
