Comment: Birlingham Parish Council objects to the siting of the new shotgun shelter. The location of the new shotgun shelter is of concern in so far as its proximity to livestock and a residence in Birlingham Parish will have a detrimental effect due to the associated noise problems.

The direction of fire appears to be towards Tyddesley wood with the possibility of a hazard to the general public from falling debris and unnecessary trauma to wildlife that use the wood as a refuge.
