Comments	<p>Birlingham Parish Council object to this retrospective planning application as the arguments put forward in the supporting documentation do not fully justify the permanent siting of caravans in this location when compared to the area of crop growing and the consequent vehicle movements which have to be made. If Wychavon District Council see fit to allow this application then Birlingham Parish Council request conditions as follows: - To restrict occupation of the caravans between March and November only, so as not to create a residential caravan site. - To restrict occupation to agricultural workers only who are employed by the applicant and not for any other purpose. - To require the removal of the caravans should they cease to be used by the farm. - To ensure that sufficient means of waste disposal are provided to ensure the area is kept free of rubbish. - Prevent cars being stored on the application site. - A means to store bicycles securely and in a tidy fashion. - Adequate screening be required around all boundaries of the site. The Parish Council are also aware that many of the workers choose to walk to Pershore and that there is no footpath or cycle route provision along the A4104 which is a road safety concern for all.</p>
